0:35: bassoon

2:15: violas

Allegro:

2:45 violins

2:59: flutes

(some call and response)

3:12: cellos do some low and fast movement
(unison strings)

3:39: spotlight on cellos

3:44: flutes (and piccolo)

4:07: clarinets

4:33: grand brass entrance (all)

5:00: cellos

5:20: violas

Adagio

5:35: Violins + backup strings (other instruments low sustained notes)

6:37: Flute and bassoon

7:00: clarinet and bassoon

7:23: all woodwinds

Moderato

8:15: strings (feat violin/viola)

8:30: (full orchestra supporting strings, you can hear timpani rolls)

10:00: clarinet

Allegro vivo

10:57: full orchestra

11:15: violins and violas do fast running passages

woodwinds offer syncopated melody, brass background rhythm

11:47: brass takes melody (trumpets)

12:57: horns do a single-note rhythm (French horns et al)

13:30: strings and woodwinds do call and response

13:58: unison; trumpets do a single-note military-esque rhythm, then take lead

14:20: we finally get to see and hear the timpani loud and clear

14:25: string unison (my favorite part)

14:55: some intense trombone and tuba

Andante

16:25: woodwinds take over, then violin/flute/piccolo in unison

17:02: more unison melody: clarinets join flute/piccolo, viola and cello join violin

17:25: violin/viola take melody

Meno

18:11: clarinet

19:15: brass, followed by woodwind
